Dear Applicant,

Thank you for considering the Sam Bass Fire Department as an opportunity to volunteer to help your community. Once you have filled out an application and have presented it to us, you will be expected to attend all drills and business meetings for the next two months or the equivalent of 8 drills and 2 business meetings. This is for you to familiarize yourself with what we do and to get to know those you will be working with. The same level of commitment is expected of all of us here at Sam Bass FD. This gives us chance to get to know you and see how you work with others. This is a time for questions as well as starting to learn the job as a Firefighter/EMT.

During the course of your two month initiation period you will also be required to do a ride out with one of the crews at either Sam Bass Station 1 or 2. Volunteer Lieutenants will help you understand what a ride out is. They will be available at all training sessions and you will be expected to schedule this with the administration at Station 2. Your application will be read at two subsequent meetings and you will also be asked to stand up at each of the two business meetings, and tell us who you are and why you want to be a member of the Sam Bass FD.

During this time we will perform a check of your criminal history and request a copy of your driving record for the last 3 years. After attending two business meetings and second reading of you application, a vote will be taken by the members in attendance that will determine your acceptance as a probationary member of the department. Once voted in we will have you do a UA test. Upon a negative result on your part you will be assigned a training team and a Lt. and the beginning or continuation of your career as a volunteer firefighter.
